**PAGE PROGRAM**

**APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS AND MATERIALS**

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To be considered for a possible nomination, a student must read all guidelines carefully and complete all of the steps below **prior to March 31, 2008**. Please send all completed materials to:

All completed applications must be returned to my office by March 31, 2008. **No exceptions will be made.**

**Requirements:**

1. **AGE** – Pages must be at least 16 years old on the day the page term in which they will serve begins. (For this term the date will be June 8, 2008). Verification of age is required.
2. **Grade Level** – A page serving during the summer term must have completed the 10<sup>th</sup> grade and not yet entered the 12<sup>th</sup> grade.
3. **Academic Requirements** – Page Board Regulations require that candidates must have maintained at least a 3.0 academic Grade Point Average, if grading is on a numerical scale, the GPA must be at least 85.
4. **Citizenship** – All eligible applicants must be United States Citizens.
5. **Domicile** – All applicants for this position must reside in the Second Congressional District of Kansas.
6. **Appointment** – Congresswoman Nancy Boyda will nominate one student from the Second Congressional District of Kansas to the Congressional Page Program. All students who have been nominated from districts across the country can only be appointed by the Speaker, the Honorable Nancy Pelosi of California. Every session, the Speaker chooses a different group of House Members to submit nominations. No other office or individual can appoint a page. If you are the nominee for the Second District of Kansas and you are appointed, you will receive confirmations in a letter from the Speaker of the House.

**Materials:**

7. **Resume** – Provide a detailed listing of your academic, community service, extracurricular and athletic activities, and other notable accomplishments.
4. **Essay** – Compose an essay of 250-300 words, which provides insight into why you desire to serve as a Congressional Page. This is also an opportunity to share why you would be the best candidate to receive the nomination for this position.
5. **Letters of Recommendation** – Submit three letters of recommendation from people not related to you. Letters should come from a school administrator or teacher; or someone who can assess your intellect, character, and suitability for the Congressional Page Program. At least one letter must come from a current teacher.
7. **Official Transcripts** – Submit a copy of your official transcripts to be sent directly from your High School to the above address.
8. **School Report Card** – Submit a copy of your most recent school report card.

**Once a nominee for the Second District of Kansas has been selected, my office will follow up with the nominated student. At this time we will provide the nomination release forms that will be sent to the office of the Speaker of the House of Representatives for an appointment to the Congressional Page Program.**
