Kolbe – Appropriations) (Unanimous Consent-Complete**

**Consideration).** This bill provides \$21.3 billion including: \$4.7 billion for military assistance (\$2.5 billion for Israel, and \$1.8 billion for Egypt); \$1.63 billion for multilateral economic assistance (\$1 billion for the World Bank, \$115 million for the Asian Development Bank, \$328 million for International Organizations); \$15.47 billion for bilateral economic assistance (\$2.65 billion for the Economic Support Fund, \$3.26 billion for the Development Assistance Fund, \$1.57 billion for the Child Survival Fund, \$2 billion for the Millennium Challenge Corporation, \$507 million for the Andean Counterdrug Initiative; and \$750 million for Migration and Refugee Assistance). This bill provides a total of \$3.4 billion for global assistance to combat HIV/AIDS, tuberculosis and malaria; \$522 million for a new initiative designed to provide incentives for countries to embrace free trade policies -- the Trade Capacity Enhancement Fund; and \$450 million for humanitarian relief efforts in Sudan.

Yesterday, the House completed general debate of [H.R. 5522](#) and considered several amendments. Today, the House will continue consideration of this bill under a unanimous consent agreement that makes in order the following amendments. All but five of these amendments are debatable for 10 minutes each:

**Postponed Vote on the Blumenauer Amendment.** To increase the Development Assistance account by \$250 million for clean water and anti-poverty programs. This increase is offset by an equal amount from un-earmarked funds in the Foreign Military Financing account.
