Barksdale AFB, LA	Construct Base Entry Road and Entry Control Facility	This project will provide adequate access to the East Reservation of Barksdale AFB, which includes housing and over 9,000 acres available for base development. It will also tie into the proposed public highway at the intersection of interstate highways I-20 and I-220.	\$10,200,000
NAS-JRB, New Orleans LA	NAS-JRB Alert Facility	This request will provide initial design funding for a new Alert facility at NAS-JRB, New Orleans. Current facilities which were re-activated after the events of September 11, 2001 are comprised of temporary trailers well below Air Force standards for an active alert site.	\$2,000,000
Camp Minden, LA	Regional Training Institute (RTI), Design	This design request is to complete the design for Phase 2 of the RTI and will add 272,270 S.F. for the Non-Commissioned Officers Academy, the Warrior Leadership Course and MOS deployment training (88M, 21W, 21E, 31B). The RTI training is in support of the Active Duty, Reserve, and Army National Guard.	\$6,500,000
Camp Minden, LA	Regional Training Institute (RTI), Phase 2	This phase of the project will construct 86,232 S.F. for 47 TDA and 246 students providing administrative areas, classrooms/billeting for the Non-Commissioned Officers Academy, the Warrior Leadership Course, and instruct 21W students.	\$26,500,000
Camp Minden, LA	Regional Training Institute (RTI), Phase 3	This phase of the project will construct 88,190 S.F. for 156 students providing administrative areas for classrooms, office space for senior cadre and RTI staff, and student billeting for the Non-Commissioned Officers Academy and the Warrior Leadership Course.	\$26,500,000
Ft. Polk, LA	Fire & Emergency Services Center	This project will provide the installation with a state of the art emergency services center and to provide adequate space for fire department personnel; for fire equipment vehicles and equipment that is not readily accessible to fire personnel to meet Department of Defense (DoD) required response time for emergency situations.	\$5,200,000
