## This Week's Hearings and Markups

- On Thursday, the Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests and Public Lands will receive testimony on the following bills:
  - H.R. 1853 (Kirkpatrick): To clarify the jurisdiction of the Secretary of the Interior with respect to the C.C. Cragin Dam and Reservoir.
  - H.R. 4036 (Payne): To authorize National Mall Liberty Fund D.C., to establish a memorial on Federal land in the District of Columbia to honor free persons and slaves who served as soldiers and sailors or provided civilian assistance during the American Revolution. "National Liberty Memorial Act"
  - H.R. 5965 (Mollohan): To designate certain Federal land within the Monongahela National Forest as a component of the National Wilderness Preservation System. "Monongahela Conservation Legacy Act of 2010"
  - H.R. \_\_\_\_\_ (Van Hollen): To extend the sunset date for the advisory commission of the C&O Canal National Historical Park for an additional ten years.

- H.R. 4339 (Sablan): To encourage students from the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands to become civically engaged through local and Federal government fellowships. "Dr. Rita Hocog Inos Fellowship Act"
- H.R. 6015 (Bordallo): To require the Director of the Bureau of Economic Analysis of the Department of Commerce to publish certain economic data regarding territories and Freely Associated States, and for other purposes.

- Also on Thursday, the Subcommittee on Water and Power will receive testimony on the following bills:
  - M.R. 3061 (Salazar): To require the Secretary of the Interior to assess the irrigation infrastructure of the Pine River Indian Irrigation Project in the State of Colorado and provide grants to, and enter into cooperative agreements with, the Southern Ute Indian Tribe to assess, repair, rehabilitate, or reconstruct existing infrastructure, and for other purposes. "Pine River Indian Irrigation Project Act of 2009"
  - O H.R. 5039 (Loretta Sanchez): To amend the Reclamation Wastewater and Groundwater Study and Facilities Act to authorize the Secretary of the Interior to participate in the design, planning, and construction of the Groundwater Replenishment System Expansion to reclaim and reuse municipal wastewater in the Orange County, California region, and for other purposes.
  - H.R. 5413 (Baca): To authorize the Pechanga Band of Luiseno Mission Indians Water Rights Settlement, and for other purposes. "Pechanga Band of Luiseno Mission Indians Water Rights Settlement Act of 2010"
  - H.R. \_\_\_\_\_ (Doc Hastings): To amend Section 301(d) of the Hoover Power Plant Act of 1984 to provide for notice regarding certification of certain projects, and for other purposes.
