**Reserve Officers Association Modernization Act of 2009**

*As reported by the Senate Committee on the Judiciary  
on September 10, 2009*

S. 1599 would amend title 36 of the U.S. Code to update the federal charter of the Reserve Officers Association (ROA). The bill would increase the number of leadership positions of ROA, broaden eligibility requirements for some positions, and expand requirements to maintain certain official records. Because chartered organizations listed in title 36 are not agencies of the U.S. government and are not provided federal benefits, CBO estimates that enacting this bill would have no impact on the federal budget.

S. 1599 contains no intergovernmental or private-sector mandates as defined in the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act and would not affect the budgets of state, local, or tribal governments.
