Possible Amendments to the Military Quality of Life Appropriations Act, 2007

Amendments Not Pre-printed in the Congressional Record

Tiahrt (R-KS). Prohibits funds from being used to promulgate regulations without consideration of the effect of such regulations on the competitiveness of American businesses. This amendment would be subject to a point of order, but the sponsor has indicated that he will offer and withdraw this amendment just to highlight the issue.

Blumenauer (D-OR)/ Brown-Waite (R-FL). Increases funds for the Army's environmental restoration on formerly used defense sites (for cleaning up unexploded bombs and munitions on closed military bases) by \$50 million (from \$257.8 million to \$307.8 million); increases funds for the Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) <u>1990</u> account by \$27.5 million (from \$216.2 million to \$243.7 million); and decreases funds for the Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) <u>2005</u> account by \$440 million (from \$5.31 billion to \$4.87 billion).
