

Bush Administration DFI Abuses

- **The Bush Administration failed to properly account for \$8.8 billion in DFI funds.**

(SIGIR Report 05-004, January 30, 2005)

- **The Bush Administration failed to account for \$96.6 million in DFI cash intended for local reconstruction projects; U.S. officials referred for criminal prosecution.**

(SIGIR Report 05-006, April 30, 2005)

- **Halliburton overcharged by more than \$212 million under a no-bid, monopoly oil contract funded under the DFI.**

(DCAA Audits, RIO Task Orders 5-10, February 2004)

Bush Administration Violates U.N. Security Council Resolution 1483

- **The Bush Administration “violated the Resolution 1483 requirement to use DFI funds in a transparent manner.”** (SIGIR Report 05-004, January 30, 2005)
- **The Bush Administration’s “use of DFI resources that is not for the benefit of the Iraqi people is in conflict with U.N. Security Council Resolution 1483.”** (IAMB Statement, April 29, 2005)
- **At Halliburton’s request, the Bush Administration redacted over 460 references to DFI overcharges in audits provided to the United Nations.** (DCAA Audits, RIO Task Orders 5-10, Aug.-Oct., 2004)
