Dear Mr. Moore:

An economic and environmental catastrophe appears to be unfolding in the Gulf of Mexico. A key question, which the Committee is examining, is what caused the explosion on the Deepwater Horizon drilling rig and the oil spill now spreading across the Gulf. Answering this question as soon as possible will help prevent future incidents and inform the direction of our national energy policy.

In order to assist the Committee with its preparation for the hearing, we ask that you provide the Committee with any documents in your possession or that you have prepared that relate to the causes or potential causes of the Deepwater Horizon rig incident. In addition, we ask that you provide to the Committee any documents relating to the testing of the blowout preventer in the event of an accidental release of oil or gas at the Deepwater Horizon drilling rig, at other offshore deep water or ultra-deep water drilling facilities, or prior to its use at a drilling facility, as well as any maintenance or testing instructions or alerts provided to purchasers or lessees of the blowout preventer or similar models of blowout preventers manufactured by your company.

We ask that you provide these documents by Monday, May 10, 2010. An attachment to this letter provides additional information on how to respond to Committee document requests.
