
Dear Mr. Moore:

As events have played out in the catastrophic oil spill in the Gulf of Mexico, numerous reports have focused on the blowout preventer as a key part of the inquiry into what happened at the site of the Deepwater Horizon drilling rig. Answering questions about that piece of equipment and its function as soon as possible will help prevent future incidents and inform the direction of our national energy policy.

As part of the Committee's on-going investigation, the Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations will hold a hearing on May 12, 2010, at 10 a.m. in Room 2123 of the Rayburn House Office Building to examine the cause of the oil spill. We request your testimony at this hearing.
