5 (E) repeals the alternative minimum tax
6 (commonly known as the AMT),

7 (F) retains and improves refundable tax
8 credits that encourage work and education
9 while lifting millions of Americans out of pov-
10 erty,

11 (G) eliminates tax breaks for businesses
12 that move jobs and profits overseas in combina-
13 tion with a reduction in tax rates for American
14 manufacturers, which are vital to innovation
15 and job growth, and

16 (H) preserves and improves incentives for
17 small business investment and growth.
