Page 14, after line 2, insert the following new paragraph:

1 (3) NO APPLICATION OF STAND-YOUR-GROUND
2 LAWS.—Nothing in this title shall be construed so as
3 to allow the application of any State law that pro-
4 vides that a person may use deadly force when there
5 is an alternative to retreat (commonly referred to as
6 a “Stand-your-ground law”) on Federal public land.

Page 18, after line 18, insert the following new paragraph:

7 (3) NO APPLICATION OF STAND-YOUR-GROUND
8 LAWS.—Nothing in this title shall be construed so as
9 to allow the application of any State law that pro-
10 vides that a person may use deadly force when there
11 is an alternative to retreat (commonly referred to as
12 a “Stand-your-ground law”) on National Monument
13 land.
