

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 1891
OFFERED BY MRS. DAVIS OF CALIFORNIA**

Add at the end the following:

1 **SEC. 3. TEACHER AND PRINCIPAL TRAINING AND RECRUIT-**
2 **ING.**

3 Section 2123(a) of the Elementary and Secondary
4 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 6623(a)) is amended
5 by inserting after paragraph (8), the following:

6 “(9) Except in the case of an activity described
7 in this paragraph that, not later than 90 days after
8 the date of enactment of the Setting New Priorities
9 in Education Spending Act, the Secretary deter-
10 mines is authorized under another provision of this
11 Act, carrying out the following teacher and principal
12 activities (which may be carried out through a part-
13 nership between the local educational agency and a
14 public entity, community-based organization, institu-
15 tion of higher education, or business):

16 “(A) Developing teacher standards that in-
17 clude measures tied to increased student aca-
18 demic achievement.

1 “(B) Carrying out outreach, teacher re-
2 recruitment, teacher subsidy, or teacher support
3 programs, related to teacher certification or
4 continuing education.

5 “(C) Carrying out programs to assist high-
6 need local educational agencies in recruiting
7 and training principals, including through fi-
8 nancial incentives to aspiring new principals,
9 for principals who agree to mentor other prin-
10 cipals, and for teachers who want to become
11 principals.

12 “(D) Carrying out professional develop-
13 ment programs in instructional leadership and
14 management.”.
