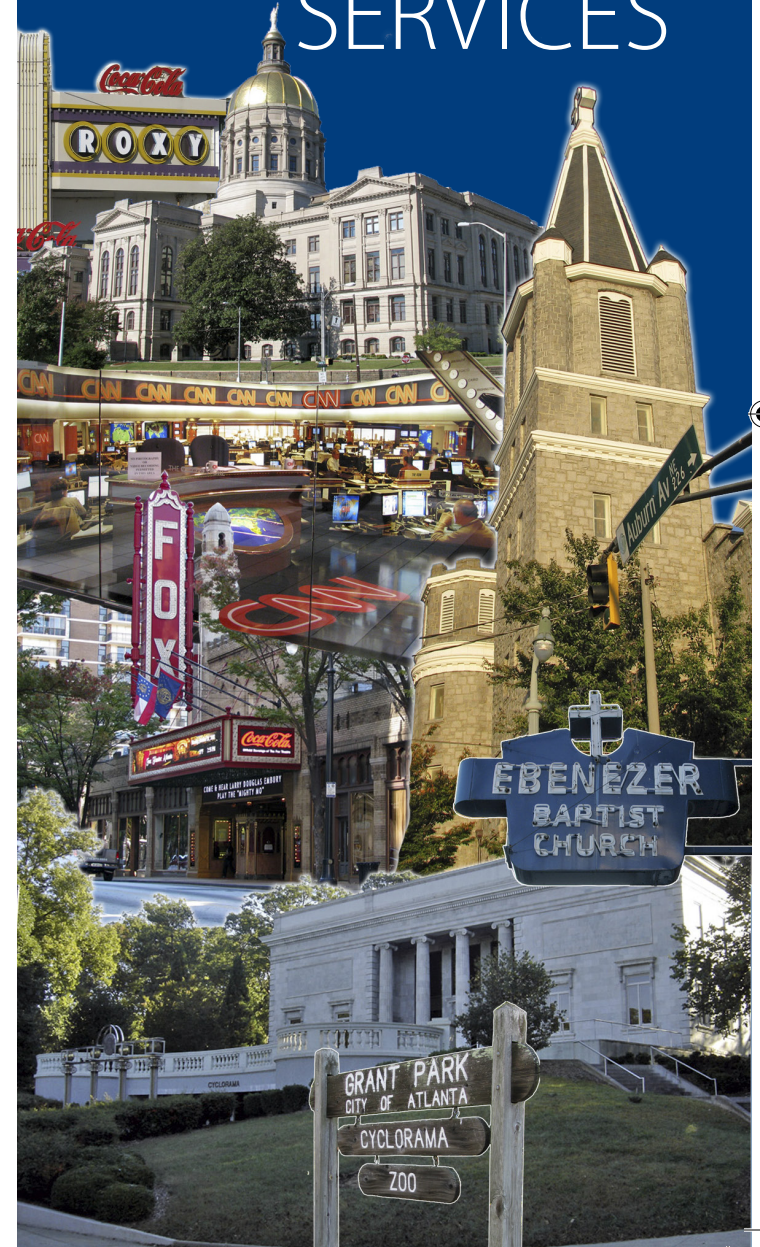

### Senior Citizens

I can help you determine what services Medicare covers, solve reimbursement problems, and inquire about overdue Social Security payments for disability, Supplemental Security Income, survivor, and retirement benefits.

### Service Academy Nominations

Are you interested in a career with the Army, Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard or Merchant Marines? Each year, based on merit, I recommend qualified students from the 5th Congressional District for admission to each of the Service Academies.

### Passports and Visas

In emergency situations, I can help expedite passport applications, solve problems with visas, and provide travel information directly from U.S. embassies abroad.

### Veterans

If you have served our nation, I can inquire about your pension or compensation benefits to which you are entitled, as well as recover service medals earned.

### U.S. Flags

I can obtain, at cost, U.S. Flags flown over the Capitol Building. Each Flag comes with a certificate of authenticity with the date it was flown. Please visit my website for instructions and prices.
