- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Cooperative Manage-
- 5 ment of Mineral Rights Act of 2016".
- 6 SEC. 2. REPEAL OF PROVISIONS REGARDING THE ALLE-
- 7 GHENY NATIONAL FOREST.
- 8 (a) Repeal.—Subsection (b) of section 17 of the Min-
- 9 eral Leasing Act (30 U.S.C. 226) and 2508 of the Energy
- 10 Policy Act of 1992 (Public Law 102–486; 106 Stat. 3108)
- 11 are repealed.
- 12 (b) Notice Requirement Not Affected.—Nothing
- 13 in this Act shall be construed or interpreted to (1) limit,
- 14 modify, or otherwise affect the existing requirement to pro-
- 15 vide in writing 60-day advance notice of specific activities
- 16 in accordance with the order dated December 16, 1980 in
- 17 the case United States of America v. Minard Run Oil Com-
- 18 pany, 1980 U.S. Dist. LEXIS 9570 (W.D. Pa., Dec. 16,
- 19 1980); or (2) limit existing authority of the Forest Service
- 20 under 16 U.S.C. 551.
