A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to make permanent the rule allowing certain tax-free distributions from individual retirement accounts for charitable purposes.

1 **SECTION 1. RULE ALLOWING CERTAIN TAX-FREE DIS-**
2 **TRIBUTIONS FROM INDIVIDUAL RETIREMENT**
3 **ACCOUNTS FOR CHARITABLE PURPOSES**
4 **MADE PERMANENT.**

5 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 408(d)(8) of the Internal
6 Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by striking subpara-
7 graph (F).

8 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
9 this section shall apply to distributions made in taxable
10 years beginning after December 31, 2014.

11 **SEC. 2. BUDGETARY EFFECTS.**

12 The budgetary effects of this Act shall not be entered
13 on either PAYGO scorecard maintained pursuant to sec-
14 tion 4(d) of the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010.

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
