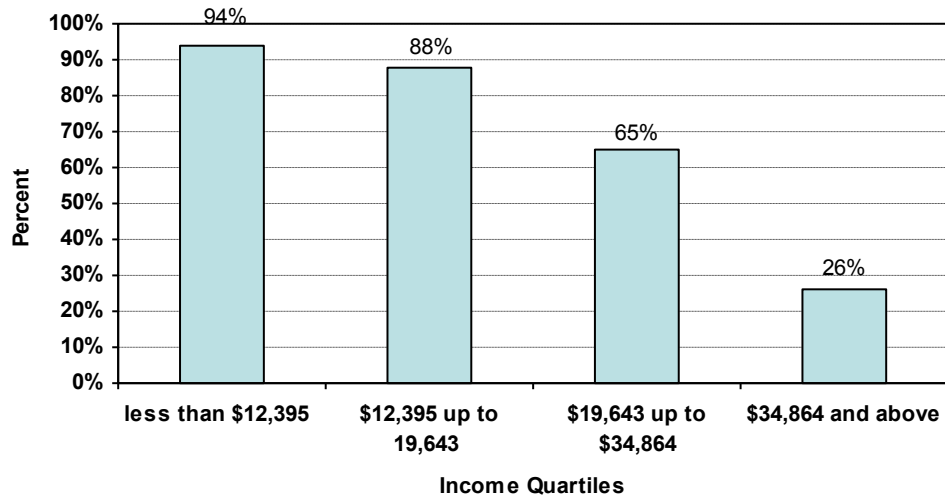


Figure 1-1-- Social Security Benefits as a Share of Total Income Among Beneficiaries Age 65 and Older in 2012 by Income Quartile
