AN ACT

To provide for the conveyance of land of the Illiana Health Care System of the Department of Veterans Affairs in Danville, Illinois.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. LAND CONVEYANCE, DANVILLE, ILLINOIS.**

2 (a) CONVEYANCE AUTHORIZED.—The Secretary of
3 Veterans Affairs may convey to the Danville Area Commu-
4 nity College of Danville, Illinois, all right, title, and inter-
5 est of the United States in and to certain real property,
6 including any improvements thereon, consisting of ap-
7 proximately .6 acres known as “Building Number 48”,
8 which is part of the Illiana Health Care System of the
9 Department of Veterans Affairs.

10 (b) CONSIDERATION.—As consideration for the con-
11 veyance under subsection (a), the Danville Area Commu-
12 nity College shall convey to the United States all right,
13 title, and interest of Danville Area Community College in
14 and to certain real property, including any improvements
15 thereon, consisting of approximately 1.06 acres with a ga-
16 zebo located approximately 293 feet south of the Danville
17 Area Community College Library Building, which is part
18 of the Danville Area Community College.

19 (c) CONDITION OF CONVEYANCE.—The conveyance
20 under subsection (a) shall be subject to the condition that
21 the recipient accept the conveyed real property in its con-
22 dition at the time of the conveyance.

23 (d) DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY.—The exact acreage
24 and legal description of the parcels of real property con-
25 veyed under subsections (a) and (b) shall be determined
26 by surveys satisfactory to the Secretary.

1 (e) ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The
2 Secretary may require such additional terms and condi-
3 tions in connection with the conveyances under subsections
4 (a) and (b) as the Secretary considers appropriate to pro-
5 tect the interests of the United States.
