3 **SECTION 1. EXPANDING EXCEPTION FOR LONG-TERM**
4 **LEASES.**

5 The Act of August 9, 1955 (commonly known as the
6 Indian Long-Term Leasing Act; 25 U.S.C. 415(a)), is
7 amended in subsection (a) of the first section—

1 (1) by striking “the Puyallup Tribe of Indi-
2 ans,,” and inserting “the Puyallup Tribe of Indians,
3 the Pueblo of Santa Clara,”;

4 (2) by striking “leases of the the lands com-
5 prising the Moses Allotment Numbered 8” and in-
6 serting “leases of the lands comprising the Moses
7 Allotment Numbered 8”; and

8 (3) by striking “lands held in trust for the
9 Pueblo of Santa Clara,”.
