# AN ACT

For the relief of Suchada Kwong.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

#### SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR SUCHADA

- 2 KWONG.
- 3 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
- 4 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
- 5 Act, Suchada Kwong shall be eligible for issuance of an
- 6 immigrant visa or for adjustment of status to that of an
- 7 alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence upon fil-
- 8 ing an application for issuance of an immigrant visa under
- 9 section 204 of such Act or for adjustment of status to
- 10 lawful permanent resident.
- 11 (b) Adjustment of Status.—If Suchada Kwong
- 12 enters the United States before the filing deadline speci-
- 13 fied in subsection (c), she shall be considered to have en-
- 14 tered and remained lawfully and shall, if otherwise eligible,
- 15 be eligible for adjustment of status under section 245 of
- 16 the Immigration and Nationality Act as of the date of the
- 17 enactment of this Act.
- 18 (c) Deadline for Application and Payment of
- 19 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-
- 20 plication for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-
- 21 tion for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees
- 22 within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.
- 23 (d) Reduction of Immigrant Visa Number.—
- 24 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-
- 25 idence to Suchada Kwong, the Secretary of State shall in-
- 26 struct the proper officer to reduce by 1, during the current

- 1 or next following fiscal year, the total number of immi-
- 2 grant visas that are made available to natives of the coun-
- 3 try of the alien's birth under section 203(a) of the Immi-
- 4 gration and Nationality Act or, if applicable, the total
- 5 number of immigrant visas that are made available to na-
- 6 tives of the country of the alien's birth under section
- 7 202(e) of such Act.
- 8 (e) Denial of Preferential Immigration
- 9 Treatment for Certain Relatives.—The natural
- 10 parents, brothers, and sisters of Suchada Kwong shall not,
- 11 by virtue of such relationship, be accorded any right, privi-
- 12 lege, or status under the Immigration and Nationality Act.
