

Statement on the Attack in Benghazi

Press Statement Hillary Rodham Clinton Secretary of State Washington, DC September 11, 2012

I condemn in the strongest terms the attack on our mission in Benghazi today. As we work to secure our personnel and facilities, we have confirmed that one of our State Department officers was killed. We are heartbroken by this termine loss. Our thoughts and prayers are with his family and those who have suffered in this attack.

This evening, I called Libyan President Magariat to coordinate additional support to protect Americans in Libya. President Magariat expressed his condemnation and condolences and piedged his government's full cooperation.

Some have sought to justify this vicious behavior as a response to inflammatory material posted on the internet. The United States deplores any intentional effort to designate the religious beliefs of others. Our commitment to religious tolerance goes back to the very beginning of our nation. But let me be clear. There is never any justification for violent acts of this kind.

In light of the events of today, the United States government is working with partner countries around the world to protect our personnel, our missions, and American citizens worldwide

Colleagues, I mentioned to Andy this morning, and want to share with all of view at Embassy Tippoli that we must be cautious in our local messaging wid to the inflammatory film trailer, adapting it to Libyan conditions. Our monitor the Libyan media and conversations with Libyans suggest that the films not a replositor of an issue here as it appears to be in other countries in the region overwhelming majority of the FB comments and tweets we've received from since the Ambassdor's death have expressed deep sympathy, sorrow, and reg They have expressed larger at the attackers, and emphasized that this attack of expressor Libyans or Islam. Relatively few have even mentioned the inflamm video. So if we post messaging about the video specifically, we may draw um attention to it.
