- Eliminate \$500 million for a Department of Defense slush fund.
- Eliminate \$115 million for alternative energy programs inside the Department of Defense.
- Cut \$8.5 million for the Greenhouse Gas Registry, which is being used by the Obama Administration to implement its job-killing Cap-and-Trade emissions program that I oppose.

Smart Energy Policies Working to End Energy Subsidies:

WORKING TO ELIMINATE ENERGY EARMARKS:

Energy subsidies waste money and lead to higher gasoline and electricity bills for hard-working Kansans.

Congressman Pompeo introduced The Energy Freedom and Economic Prosperity Act (H.R.3308) to end all energy tax credits and stop the government from trying to pick winners and losers in the energy sector.

Congressman Pompeo is also pursuing those members of the Administration who are accountable for losing over \$500 million of your tax money on Solyndra. Congressman Pompeo believes the government should not use taxpayer dollars to bail out failing businesses or grant personal favors.

HONORING FATHER KAPAUN:

Congressman Pompeo has worked hard to ensure that Father Kapaun, a Korean War hero and a native Kansan, posthumously receives the Medal of Honor award. Father Kapaun was a source of strength and protection for his fellow prisoners of war until his captors separated him and left him to die alone in a Chinese prison hospital.

Congressman Pompeo testified before the House Armed Services Committee to respectfully request the Committee to waive the time limitation for issuing Father Kapaun the Medal of Honor. Because of Congressman Pompeo's testimony, a waiver was included in the National Defense Authorization Act and is now law.

National Policy Battles Putting Kansas Before Washington:

ENDING WASTEFUL PROGRAMS AND AGENCIES:

Congressman Pompeo introduced the EPA Student Nondiscrimination Act. This bill would end an Environmental Protection Agency fellowship program that uses your tax money to train environmental activists.

He also introduced the EDA Elimination Act of 2011 to defund the Economic Development Administration. If successful, this bill would be the largest elimination of a federal agency in decades. Senator Jim DeMint has introduced a companion bill in the Senate. If passed, the bill would save \$300 million in tax money each year.

PRESERVING GUN RIGHTS:

Congressman Pompeo has consistently voted in favor of bills and resolutions to protect the second amendment gun rights of all Kansans. For example, he's a firm supporter of The National Rightto-Carry Reciprocity Act of 2011 which allows individuals with concealed carry permits to carry a firearm in other right-to-carry states.

PROTECTING FARMERS & RANCHERS IN KANSAS:

Congressman Pompeo shepherded the Farm Dust Regulation Prevention Act of 2011 to House passage. This bill would ensure the Environmental Protection Agency does not regulate farm dust kicked up by ordinary farm and agriculture activities.

Key Kansas Industries Fighting for Local Job Creation:

Congressman Pompeo discusses the challenges facing the district's aviation industry.

STANDING UP FOR GENERAL AVIATION:

Congressman Pompeo introduced the Blocked Aircraft Registration Request Preservation Act, in order to ensure general aviation users have the privacy they need and deserve and the Pompeo language is now law.

He also has fought vocally and publicly against President Obama's demonization of the general aviation industry. He has also strongly opposed general aviation user fees, which if enacted would devastate the industry.

FIGHTING TO REPEAL PRESIDENT'S HEALTH CARE LAW:

Congressman Pompeo co-sponsored and voted for the repeal of the President's Health Care Law, which passed the House overwhelmingly.

Congressman Pompeo also voted for legislation that would reduce healthcare costs for seniors and preserve Medicare for the next generation.

STOPPING ILLEGAL IMMIGRATION:

Congressman Pompeo introduced the Build the Fence Now Act. This bill will require the construction of a double-layered fence along the entire U.S.-Mexico border. It would also require the use of unmanned aerial vehicles and satellites to monitor the U.S-Mexico border and the U.S-Canada border.
