A BILL

To repeal section 2141 of the Revised Statutes to remove the prohibition on certain alcohol manufacturing on Indian lands.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF PROHIBITION ON CERTAIN ALCO-**
4 **HOL MANUFACTURING ON INDIAN LANDS.**

5 Section 2141 of the Revised Statutes (25 U.S.C. 251)
6 is repealed.

1 **SEC. 2. NO EFFECT ON TAXATION OR STATE AUTHORITY TO**
2 **REGULATE ALCOHOL WITHIN STATE BOR-**
3 **DERS.**

4 (a) **NO EFFECT ON TAXATION.**—Nothing in section
5 1 or the repeal made by section 1 shall affect State or
6 Federal taxation.

7 (b) **STATE AUTHORITY UNAFFECTED.**—Nothing in
8 section 1 or the repeal made by section 1 shall diminish,
9 enlarge, or otherwise affect a State’s authority to regulate
10 the importation and sale of alcoholic beverages within its
11 own borders, including State authority over the manufac-
12 ture, distribution, transportation, or sale of intoxicating
13 liquors.
