A BILL

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Comprehensive Care
3 for Seniors Act of 2018”.

4 **SEC. 2. DIRECTING THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND**
5 **HUMAN SERVICES TO ISSUE A FINAL REGU-**
6 **LATION BASED ON THE PROPOSED REGULA-**
7 **TION RELATING TO THE PROGRAMS OF ALL-**
8 **INCLUSIVE CARE FOR THE ELDERLY (PACE)**
9 **UNDER THE MEDICARE AND MEDICAID PRO-**
10 **GRAMS.**

11 Not later than December 31, 2018, the Secretary of
12 Health and Human Services shall issue a final regulation
13 based on the provisions of the proposed regulation titled
14 “Medicare and Medicaid Programs; Programs of All-In-
15 clusive Care for the Elderly (PACE)” (81 Fed. Reg.
16 54666).

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to direct the Secretary of Health and Human Services to issue a final regulation based on the proposed regulation relating to the Programs of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) under the Medicare and Medicaid programs.”.
