Page 6, line 23, strike “and”.

Page 7, line 3, strike the period and insert a semi-colon.

Page 7, beginning line 4, insert the following:

1 (4) information regarding the degree to which
2 fitness determinations made by the Department and
3 its components or other Federal agencies are recog-
4 nized on a reciprocal basis by the Department and
5 its components pursuant to subsection (c)(1);

6 (5) information regarding the degree to which
7 suitability and fitness determinations for Federal ap-
8 plicants and appointees made by the Department
9 and its components or other Federal agencies are
10 recognized on a reciprocal basis by the Department
11 and its components; and

12 (6) information regarding the degree to which
13 the Secretary, acting through the Chief Security Of-
14 ficer of the Department, uses the authority under
15 subsection (c)(2).

1 (h) SUITABILITY STATUS UPDATES.—Not later than
2 one year after the date of the enactment of this Act, the
3 Chief Security Officer of the Department of Homeland Se-
4 curity, in consultation with the Chief Human Capital Offi-
5 cer of the Department, shall develop a plan to provide
6 Federal applicants and appointees with suitability and fit-
7 ness determination status updates similar to updates pro-
8 vided to contractor representatives under subsection (d).
