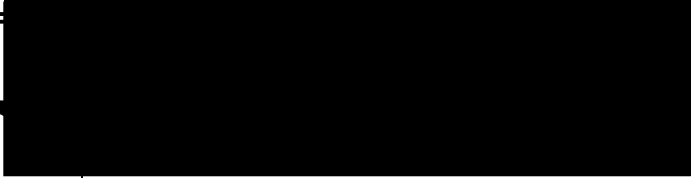

John Dicken is a Director for Health Care issues at the U.S. Government Accountability Office where he directs GAO evaluations on public health and private markets issues, including private health insurance, prescription drug pricing, FDA drug approvals, and nursing home quality of care. Recent areas of focus for GAO reports under Mr. Dicken's leadership include evaluation of health insurance provisions of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, health benefits offered to federal and U.S. Postal Service employees and retirees, prescription drug payment and pricing, and FDA drug approvals. He has also led GAO evaluations of nursing home quality of care and long-term care insurance. He previously held Analyst and Assistant Director roles with GAO's Health Care team. In addition to his more than twenty-five years of GAO experience, Mr. Dicken was a Senior Analyst for the Presidential Advisory Commission on Consumer Protection and Quality in the Health Care Industry and a legislative fellow with the majority health staff of the Senate Committee on Labor and Human Resources (since renamed the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions). Mr. Dicken is a graduate of Carleton College and has a Master of Public Administration degree from Columbia University.
