

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE  
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 6510  
OFFERED BY MR. GRIJALVA OF ARIZONA**

Add at the end the following:

1 **SEC. 3. PERMANENT AUTHORIZATION AND FULL FUNDING**  
2 **OF THE LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION**  
3 **FUND.**

4 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—Section 200302 of title 54,  
5 United States Code, is amended—

6 (1) in subsection (b), in the matter preceding  
7 paragraph (1), by striking “During the period end-  
8 ing September 30, 2018, there” and inserting  
9 “There”; and

10 (2) in subsection (c)(1), by striking “through  
11 September 30, 2018”.

12 (b) FULL FUNDING.—

13 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 200303 of title 54,  
14 United States Code, is amended to read as follows:

15 **“§ 200303. Availability of funds**

16 “(a) IN GENERAL.—Amounts deposited in the Fund  
17 under section 200302 shall be made available for expendi-  
18 ture, without further appropriation or fiscal year limita-  
19 tion, to carry out the purposes of the Fund (including ac-

1 counts and programs made available from the Fund under  
2 the Consolidated and Further Continuing Appropriations  
3 Act, 2015 (Public Law 113–235)).

4 “(b) ADDITIONAL AMOUNTS.—Amounts made avail-  
5 able under subsection (a) shall be in addition to amounts  
6 made available to the Fund under section 105 of the Gulf  
7 of Mexico Energy Security Act of 2006 (43 U.S.C. 1331  
8 note; Public Law 109–432) or otherwise appropriated  
9 from the Fund.

10 “(c) ALLOCATION AUTHORITY.—

11 “(1) SUBMISSION OF COST ESTIMATES.—The  
12 President shall submit to Congress detailed account,  
13 program, and project allocations to be funded under  
14 subsection (a) as part of the annual budget submis-  
15 sion of the President.

16 “(2) ALTERNATE ALLOCATION.—

17 “(A) IN GENERAL.—Appropriations Acts  
18 may provide for alternate allocation of amounts  
19 made available under subsection (a), including  
20 allocations by account and program.

21 “(B) ALLOCATION BY PRESIDENT.—

22 “(i) NO ALTERNATE ALLOCATIONS.—  
23 If Congress has not enacted legislation es-  
24 tablishing alternate allocations by the date  
25 that is 120 days after the date on which

1 the applicable fiscal year begins, amounts  
2 made available under subsection (a) shall  
3 be allocated by the President.

4 “(ii) INSUFFICIENT ALTERNATE AL-  
5 LOCATION.—If Congress enacts legislation  
6 establishing alternate allocations for  
7 amounts made available under subsection  
8 (a) that are less than the full amount ap-  
9 propriated under that subsection, the dif-  
10 ference between the amount appropriated  
11 and the alternate allocation shall be allo-  
12 cated by the President.

13 “(3) ANNUAL REPORT.—The President shall  
14 submit to Congress an annual report that describes  
15 the final allocation by account, program, and project  
16 of amounts made available under subsection (a), in-  
17 cluding a description of the status of obligations and  
18 expenditures.”.

19 (2) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sec-  
20 tions for chapter 2003 of title 54, United States  
21 Code, is amended by striking the item relating to  
22 section 200303 and inserting the following:

“200303. Availability of funds.”.

23 (c) PARITY FOR TERRITORIES AND THE DISTRICT OF  
24 COLUMBIA.—Section 200305(b) of title 54, United States  
25 Code, is amended by striking paragraph (5).

1 (d) PUBLIC ACCESS.—Section 200306 of title 54,  
2 United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the  
3 following:

4 “(c) PUBLIC ACCESS.—Not less than 1.5 percent of  
5 the annual authorized funding amount shall be made  
6 available each year for projects that secure recreational  
7 public access to existing Federal public land for hunting,  
8 fishing, or other recreational purposes.”.
