A BILL

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 1320 Autumn Avenue in Memphis, Tennessee, as the “Judge Russell B. Sugarmon Post Office Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. JUDGE RUSSELL B. SUGARMON POST OFFICE**
2 **BUILDING.**

3 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
4 Postal Service located at 1325 Autumn Avenue in Mem-
5 phis, Tennessee, shall be known and designated as the
6 “Judge Russell B. Sugarmon Post Office Building”.

7 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
8 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
9 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
10 be deemed to be a reference to the “Judge Russell B.
11 Sugarmon Post Office Building”.

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to designate
the facility of the United States Postal Service located at
1325 Autumn Avenue in Memphis, Tennessee, as the
‘Judge Russell B. Sugarmon Post Office Building’.”.
