

您的公民权利受到保护

he Department of the Treasury – Internal Revenue Service prohibits discrimination against taxpayers based on race, color, national origin (including limited English proficiency), sex, religion, disability, and age in its programs and activities. Additional bases, such as sexual orientation and status as a parent, apply in education and training programs conducted by the Internal Revenue Service.

Taxpayers with a disability may request a reasonable accommodation and taxpayers with limited English proficiency may request language assistance to access service.

财政部一联邦国税局禁止基于种族、肤色、原国籍(包括英语水平有限者)、性别、宗教、残疾以及年龄等因素在局内各项计划与活动中對纳税人进行歧视。国税局的教育与培训计划有额外的适用规定,例如禁止基于性取向和作为父母的身分状态(status as a parent)的歧视行为。

具有残疾的纳税人可要求合理的调整安排,英语能力有限者可要求语言协助以便获得服务。
