


Most people experience pain at some point in their lives

WHAT IS CHRONIC PAIN?

CHRONIC PAIN is considered a

disease itself. It can be influenced by environmental and psychological factors and is resistant to most medical treatments.



FUNDING RESEARCH

In 2013, NIH provided \$402 million in funding for chronic pain conditions.
