

## 2018 IMPORTANT DEADLINE DATES

January 1	Offices closed in observance of New Year's Day
January 2	Reporting date for 2018 honeybee colonies/honey for all FSA programs
January 15	Reporting date for 2018 acreage for apples
January 15	Offices closed in observance of Martin Luther King, Jr's Birthday
January 30	Deadline to apply for 2017 Livestock Forage Disaster Program (LFP) and 2017 Livestock Indemnity Program (LIP)
January 31	Deadline to file Tree Assistance Program (TAP) application
February 2	Deadline to apply for Loan Deficiency Payments (LDP) for unshorn pelts produced during the 2017 crop year
February 15	NAP buy-up premiums due
February 19	Offices closed in observance of George Washington's Birthday
March 31	Final date to obtain loans or Loan Deficiency Payments (LDP's) on 2017 harvested small grains
April 9	Enrollment re-opened for 2018 Margin Protection Program for Dairy (MPP-Dairy) <i>Note: previous 2018 enrollment period contracts null and void – all must re-enroll</i>
May 28	Offices closed in observance of Memorial Day
May 31	Final date to obtain loans or LDP's on 2017 harvested feed grains and soybeans
June 1	Date used to establish ownership interest for person or legal entity for program purposes
June 1	Date used for the determination of minor child for program purposes
June 1	Deadline to enroll for 2018 Margin Protection Program for Dairy (MPP-Dairy)
June 15	Reporting date for cucumbers (Planted 5/1 to 5/31) in Knox County
June 20	Final date to submit a prevented planting claim for corn
July 4	Offices closed in observance of Independence Day
July 5	Final date to submit a prevented planting claim for soybeans
July 15	Reporting date for all other crops (including cucumbers planted 5/10-6/15) in all other counties in Indiana
August 1	Deadline to request farm reconstitutions and transfers for 2018
August 15	Reporting date for cucumbers (planted 6/16-8/5 in Fulton, LaPorte, Porter and St. Joseph Counties)
September 3	Offices closed in observance of Labor Day
September 4	Signup begins for Market Facilitation Program (MFP)
September 15	Reporting date for cucumbers (planted 6/1-8/15 in Knox County)
September 28	Deadline to enroll in 2018 Agriculture Risk Coverage (ARC) or Price Loss Coverage (PLC) Programs
September 28	2018 MPP-Dairy premiums due
September 30	Reporting date for value loss and controlled environment crop (for the coming program year)
September 30	Deadline to report changes in interest on ARC or PLC contracts
October 8	Offices closed in observance of Columbus Day
November 4	Final date to submit a prevented planting claim for 2019 fall wheat with 10/20 final plant date
November 12	Offices closed in observance of Veteran's Day
November 15	Final date to submit a prevented planting claim for 2019 fall wheat with 10/31 final plant date
November 22	Offices closed in observance of Thanksgiving Day
December 3	Final application for payment for 2017 ELAP, LIP, LFP for losses occurring 10/1/2016 to 9/30/2017
December 3	Final application for payment for 2018 ELAP for losses occurring 10/1/2017 to 9/30/2018
December 3	Final application for payment for 2017 and 2018 TAP losses
December 15	Reporting date for 2019 fall mint, fall-seeded small grains
December 25	Offices closed in observance of Christmas Day

NOTE: The final acreage reporting dates are listed in this table. However, the final date for reporting any specific crop acreage **for which NAP assistance may be paid is earlier of the date listed above or 15 calendar days BEFORE the onset of harvest or grazing.**

### APPLICATION DEADLINES FOR COVERAGE FOR NAP FINAL DATES

March 15	Annual spring/summer planted crops not limited to: beans, beets, broccoli, brussel sprouts, cabbage, canola, cantaloupes, carrots, cauliflower, corn, cucumbers, eggplant, garlic, greens, herbs, honeydew, lettuce, oats, okra, onions, peas, peppers, potatoes, pumpkins, radishes, sorghum, squash, tomatillos, tomatoes, and watermelon
May 1	Nursery (ornamental nursery and nonornamental propagation nursery) for the crop year June 1 - May 31
September 1	Value loss crops for the following year (flowers for fresh cut, onion sets, turfgrass sod, Christmas trees, aquaculture, ginseng, mushrooms, etc.)
September 30	Garlic, wheat, barley, rye and mint for the following year's crop
November 15	Perennial grazing and forage crops (alfalfa, grass, mixed forages, clover, etc.)
November 20	Apples, apricots, aronia (chokeberry), asparagus, blueberries, caneberries, cherries, grapes, hops, nectarines, peaches, pears, plums, strawberries
December 1	Honey for the following year
