




What has changed: Chinese Domestic Solar Consumption Has Expanded






Other Major Non- U.S. Markets Have Strong Demand Outlook



U.S. Imports from China Have Fallen Dramatically Since 2015




U.S. Imports From China Would Have Been Miniscule in 2017 But for Effect of the 201
