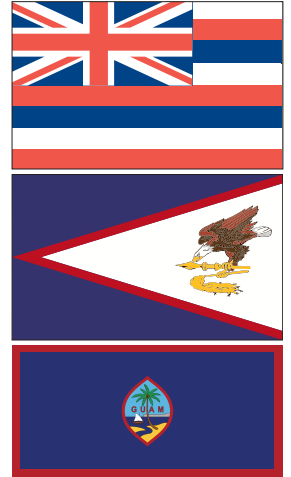

- The urban population of Hawaii in 1980 was 833,556. As of 2015, the urban population in Hawaii increased to 1,163,440. In the same span of 35 years, the rural population increased from 131,135 to 268,163.
- As of 2011, there are a total of 98 certified organic agriculture operations. All operations total 6,819 acres.
- 3,000 jobs in Hawaii are supported by agriculture products.
- As of 2012, Hawaii County, followed by Maui County, is the top ranking county in state agricultural sales.
- The average age of a principal operator in Hawaii is 60.4.
- The annual value of agriculture exports from Hawaii is \$400 million.
- American Samoa's main agricultural products include bananas, coconuts, vegetables, taro, breadfruit, yams, copra, pineapples and papayas.
- American Samoa is approximately 76 square miles. The annual average of rainfall in the drier portions of the island is 125 inches to as much as 300 inches in the mountains.
