Eligible producers must apply for coverage and pay the applicable service fees annually by the application closing date. Acreage reports are also due annually. To ensure coverage availability, please call your local office. (See attached page for county-specific closing dates)

ARC/PLC: August 1 for annual enrollment

## Marketing Assistance Loans and Loan Deficiency Payments:

- March 31 for prior year harvested wheat, barley, canola, crambe, flaxseed, honey, oats, rapeseed, and sesame
- May 31 for prior year harvested corn, soybeans and other oilseeds, rice, grain sorghum, and pulse crops
- Jan. 31 for prior year harvested peanuts, wool, mohair and LDP only for unshorn pelts

- January 15, 2018 Peaches, Canola
- July 15, 2018 All Other Crops and CRP
- November 15 Perennial Forage Preceding Year (Report 2018 for 2019) NEW
- December 15 Fall Seeded Small Grains. Examples: Barley, Oats, Rye, Wheat Preceding Year (Report 2018 for 2019)

#### **Crops With NAP Coverage:**

Sept. 30, 2018 - Aquaculture; Value loss and controlled environment crops (except Nursery). Examples: Christmas Trees, Crustaceans, Finfish, Flowers, Ginseng, Grass Sod Preceding Year (Report 2018 for 2018)

January 2, 2018 - Honey (Same Crop Year)

May 31, 2018 - Nursery Preceding Year (Report 2018 for 2019)

**All Other NAP Crops are to be reported the <u>earlier</u> of:** the Acreage Reporting Dates above (or) 15 calendar days before the onset of harvest.
