Subject: NWS Alaskan Region offices will migrate to a new
 layout on its web home pages effective July 6, 2016

On, or shortly after, Wednesday, July 6, 2016, all Alaska Region (AR) NWS Weather Forecast Offices (WFOs), the AR River Forecast Center (RFC) and the AR Center Weather Service Unit (CWSU) will migrate to a new layout on the front page of their web home pages in response to a required web infrastructure. The change will also allow office to office consistency because the layout of the home page will be set across the region.
