forecast.weather.gov on hold

The National Centers for Environmental Prediction (NCEP) Central Operations (NCO) had planned to implement a major change to its Point Forecast application (http://forecast.weather.gov) on Monday, August 14, 2017, however this implementation has been postponed. A new implementation date has not yet been set.

The Public Information Statement (PNS) issued on October 17, 2016, to collect comments on this intended change is online at:

Comments on these changes were generally favorable so implementation of the new Point Forecast application is planned. The purpose of these changes is to create a more usable interface with no duplication of service to users while providing a more modern service-oriented data structure.

The October 17 PNS provided details on changes that will be made to a variety of Uniform Resource Locators (URLs) in association with this implementation. Partners and users are encouraged to refer to this PNS for

the specific technical details.
