Effective Monday, December 11, 2017, at 8 am Eastern Standard Time (EST) or 1300 Coordinated Universal Time (UTC), harmful algal bloom (HAB) forecast information provided by the Gulf of Mexico HAB Operational Forecast System (HAB-OFS) will be georeferenced in a geospatial PDF. The enhancement allows users to query interactive data layers and access the metadata associated with observations. This additional data can be used to better understand the location, impact and forecasts of a bloom.
