Effective October 16, 2017, at 1300 Coordinated Universal Time (UTC) (9AM EST), the NOAA/NOS Tides On Line Product will be discontinued by NOS/CO-OPS

The TOL product displays coastal near real time observations of water level, winds, water and air temperature and atmospheric pressure from NOS/CO-OPS NWLON stations. There are no changes to the NWLON observing system but the TOL display has become redundant with newer data dissemination pathways at https://tidesandcurrents.noaa.gov/
