 U.S. hazards outlooks effective October 24, 2018

Effective October 24, 2018, the National Centers for Environmental Prediction (NCEP) Climate Prediction Center (CPC) will transition the Prognostic Discussion for 6 to 10 and 8 to 14 day outlooks, as well as the US Hazards Outlook to mixed case. For the Prognostic Discussion for 6 to 10 and 8 to 14 day outlooks, the format of the web page presence will change from all upper-case to mixed-case:
