Eligible producers must apply for coverage and pay the applicable service fees annually by the application closing date. Acreage and production reports are also due annually.

August 1 - strawberries

September 1 - forage crops

September 15 - spinach, Swiss chard, kale

November 20 - orchard crops, honey

March 15 - melons, fresh market sweet corn, squash, pumpkins, peppers, tomatoes, most annual fruits and vegetables
