January	
1	New Year's Day Holiday. FSA offices are closed.
1	Elected County Committee members take office.
15	Final date to report apples, grapes & peaches. <i>(Since the 15th is a Federal holiday, applications will be accepted through Tuesday, Jan. 16th)</i>
15	Birthday of Martin Luther King, Jr. FSA offices are closed.
31	Final availability date for 2017 Marketing Assistance Loans & LDPs for wool & unshorn pelts.
February	
19	George Washington's Birthday. FSA offices are closed.
28	NAP application closing date for rice.
March	
15	NAP application closing date for many NAP crops, including forage and pasture.
31	Final availability date for 2017 Marketing Assistance Loans & LDPs for small grains & honey. <i>(Since the 31st falls on a weekend, reports will be accepted through Monday, April 2nd)</i>
May	
1	NAP application closing date for ornamental nursery for subsequent year.
1	Beginning of the primary nesting season for Missouri. No maintenance (mowing, spraying, burning or disking) on CRP acreage.
15	Final date to report spring oats & potatoes.
28	Memorial Day Holiday. FSA offices are closed.
31	Final availability date for 2017 Marketing Assistance Loans & LDPs for feed grains, upland cotton, soybeans & minor oilseeds.
July	
4	Independence Day. FSA offices are closed.
15	Final date to report CRP, burley tobacco, corn, cotton, grain sorghum, hybrid corn seed, popcorn, rice, soybeans & all other crops. NAP crops must be reported by the final reporting date or 15 days before harvest. <i>(Since the 15th falls on a weekend, reports will be accepted through Monday, July 16th)</i>
15	End of the primary nesting season for Missouri. CRP maintenance can begin on July 16.
August	
1	Final date to request a reconstitution-combining or dividing farms or tracts of land based on the farming operation.
1	Enrollment for 2018 ARC and PLC programs ends.
September	
1	Premium due for Margin Protection Program (MPP)-Dairy for 2018 coverage.
1	NAP application closing date for greens, aquaculture, Christmas trees, ginseng root, turf grass sod, mushrooms & floriculture.
3	Labor Day Holiday. FSA offices are closed.
30	NAP application closing date for strawberries & fall-seeded small grains. <i>(Since the 30th falls on a weekend, applications will be accepted through Monday, October 1st)</i>

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October	
8	Columbus Day Holiday. FSA offices are closed.
31	Final date to submit applications for the Organic Certification Cost Share Program for certification costs paid Oct. 1, 2017, through Sept. 30, 2018.
November	
1	Final date to submit an application for payment for 2018 losses under Emergency Assistance for Livestock, Honeybees and Farm-raised Fish Program (ELAP).
12	Veterans Day Holiday (Observed). FSA offices are closed.
15	Final date to report 2019 apiculture & pasture, rangeland & forage.
20	NAP application closing date for apples, apricots, grapes, nectarines, peaches, pears, plums, & blueberries.
22	Thanksgiving Day Holiday. FSA offices are closed.
December	
1	NAP application closing date for honey. <i>(Since the 1st falls on a weekend, applications will be accepted through Monday, December 3rd)</i>
15	Final date to report fall barley, fall wheat & all other fall-seeded small grains. <i>(Since the 15th falls on a weekend, applications will be accepted through Monday, December 17th)</i>
25	Christmas Day Holiday. FSA offices are closed.
31	NAP application closing date for potatoes.
January 2019	
1	Newly elected county committee members take office.
1	New Year's Day Holiday. FSA offices are closed.
Ongoing	
Reports of Failed Acreage must be filed with the County Office before disposition of the crop.	
Reports of Prevented Planting Acreage must be filed with the County Office no later than 15 calendar days after the final planting date for that county.	
Reports of loss under the Emergency Assistance for Livestock, Honeybees and Farm-raised Fish Program (ELAP) must be filed within 30 days after the loss is apparent.	
Reports of livestock deaths (due to adverse weather) under the Livestock Indemnity Program (LIP) must be filed within 30 days after the death is apparent. An application for payment must be filed no later than 90 calendar days after the end of the calendar year in which the eligible loss condition occurred.	
Report any losses for the Noninsured Crop Disaster Program (NAP) within 15 days of when the loss becomes apparent.	
Notify your county office of any losses under the Tree Assistance Program (TAP) within 90 calendar days of each disaster event or date when the loss of trees, bushes or vines is apparent.	
Submit application for Farm Storage Facility Loans (FSFL) before delivery of materials and/or construction begins. Do not purchase item before application is submitted.	
Applications taken for all Farm Loans including direct ownership, direct operating and microloans.
