Introductory Auditor Training Program (IA-1901)/December 4-12, 2018

If Congress reaches a budget agreement by midnight on Friday, <u>November 30</u>, 2018, CIGIE will deliver IA-1901 as scheduled starting on Tuesday, December 4, 2018. However, if no budget agreement is reached by that time, IA-1901 will be canceled and rescheduled if possible.

Please Note: This is a 7-day class and the continuing resolution is set to expire at the end of the fourth day. Due to significant uncertainty surrounding the ability of our instructors and learners to participate in days 5-7, *even if an agreement is reached by the December 7 deadline*, we cannot start the class without knowing whether the government will shut down or not.

New Leader 49 – Week 2/December 10-14

If Congress reaches a budget agreement by midnight on Friday, <u>December 7</u>, 2018, the second week of NL 49 will continue for all participants as scheduled starting on Monday, December 10, 2018.

Special Instructions for Local Students: We will make the call at 6:00 a.m. on Monday, December 10. If a budget or continuing resolution has been passed by Congress and signed by the President by then, report to class – and, if not, we will reschedule week two of NL 49 for a later date.

<u>Special Instructions for Those Traveling from Out of Town:</u> We realize that you need to make the call earlier in order to arrange travel, and we will work with you to reschedule you for a later offering if the government reopens before the first day of class, but too late for you to make travel arrangements.
