If a member of the public subsequently makes a request for any or all of this information, the Commission will base any determination to release the information on the applicable provisions of the Consumer Product Safety Act as well as the Freedom of Information Act and 18 U.S.C. 1905. Our policy is that specified in our letter to you dated March 18, 1974. You will be notified prior to the release of any information which you desire the Commission to keep confidential.
