
**ORDER**

Brian Thiel and Kristine Mako (Petitioners) request to intervene as a party pursuant to 16 C.F.R. § 1025.17(a). Alternatively, they request to participate as a non-party under 16 C.F.R. § 1025.17(b). Complaint Counsel and Respondent oppose the Petition to Intervene as Parties because the petitioners fail to make a sufficient showing of the necessary factors as required by 16 C.F.R. 1025.17(a) and (d). In reply, Petitioners withdraw their request to intervene as parties but maintain their request to intervene as a non-party participant. Complaint Counsel and Respondent do not object.

Petitioner's request to intervene as a non-party is **GRANTED**. They have the right to participate to the extent provided by 16 C.F.R. § 1025.17(b)(3).
