**Sources:** Data for 2018 for Arkansas, California, Colorado, Federal Offshore Gulf of Mexico, Kansas, Louisiana, Montana, New Mexico, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Texas, Utah, West Virginia, and Wyoming are from the Form EIA-914, *Monthly Crude Oil and Lease Condensate, and Natural Gas Production Report*. Data for 2012-2017 (all states) and 2018 for states/areas not individually reported on the EIA-914 (Alabama, Alaska, Arizona, Federal Offshore Pacific, Florida, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Michigan, Mississippi, Missouri, Nebraska, Nevada, New York, South Dakota, Tennessee, and Virginia) are from EIA estimates published in the Petroleum Supply Annual and Petroleum Supply Monthly reports, based on crude oil production data from state government agencies and the U.S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement (and predecessor agencies), and first purchase data reported on Form EIA-182, *Domestic Crude Oil First Purchase Report*. Production data for Idaho begin in August 2015.
