1. Attached for your review and approval is the Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 Priority List of Pending State and Tribal Government Cemetery Construction Grant Pre-applications. The Priority List will serve as VA's basis for awarding grants during FY 2019, which begins on October 1, 2018.

2. There are 99 total projects subject to 38CFRPART39. All applications are ranked according to the methodology in 38CFRPART39 and must meet the requirements in that part to receive a grant. As of August 15, 2018, all pending pre-applications have been ranked to establish the priority list for grant awards in FY 2019.

3. The number of projects to which VA will commit will not be known until VA's annual budget is approved.


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

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
