

USCIS Privacy Act Statement

USCIS Immigrant Fee

Authority: 8 CFR §103.7(b) 1(i) and (D) authorize the collection of this information.

Purpose: DHS/USCIS collects the requested information to process your immigrant fee payment for a Department of State issued visa. USCIS will issue your visa upon receipt of your payment.

Disclosure: The information you provide is voluntary. However, failure to provide the requested information may delay or prevent USCIS from processing and issuing your immigration visa.

Routine Uses: This information may be used by and disclosed to DHS personnel and contractors or other agents who need the information to assist in activities related to the issuance of your immigration visa. Additionally, DHS may externally disclose the information to other federal, state, local and authorized organizations in accordance with approved routine uses, as described in the associated published system of records notice, DHS-USCIS-007 - Benefits Information System, which can be found at www.dhs.gov/privacy. The information may also be made available, as appropriate for law enforcement purposes or in the interest of national security.
