4 This Act may be cited as the “Efficient Drug Dis-
5 posal Act of 2018”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCINERATION OF CONTRABAND AND HOUSEHOLD**
2 **PHARMACEUTICALS BY LAW ENFORCEMENT**
3 **AGENCIES.**

5 7429(g)(1)) is amended—

6 (1) by striking “or (C)” and inserting “(C)”;

7 and

8 (2) by striking the period at the end and insert-
9 ing “or (D) other categories of solid waste inciner-
10 ator units referred to in section (a)(1)(E) owned and
11 operated by a Federal, State, or local law enforce-
12 ment agency when used for the sole purpose of de-
13 stroying contraband or household pharmaceuticals
14 collected by a Federal, State, or local law enforce-
15 ment agency.”.
