- 7 (b) Conforming Amendments.—

- 10 (2) Paragraph (2) of section 6416(b) of such
- 11 Code is amended by striking the last sentence.
- 12 (c) Clerical Amendment.—The table of sub-
- 13 chapters for chapter 32 of such Code is amended by strik-
- 14 ing the item relating to subchapter E.
- 15 (d) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 16 this section shall apply to sales after December 31, 2019.
