A BILL

To condition the provision of premium and cost-sharing subsidies under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act upon a certification that a program to verify household income and other qualifications for such subsidies is operational, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. CONDITIONING PROVISION OF ACA PREMIUM**
2 **AND COST-SHARING SUBSIDIES UPON CER-**
3 **TIFICATION THAT A PROGRAM TO VERIFY**
4 **HOUSEHOLD INCOME AND OTHER QUALI-**
5 **FICATIONS FOR THOSE SUBSIDIES IS OPER-**
6 **ATIONAL.**

7 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no pre-
8 mium tax credits shall be allowed under section 36B of
9 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and no reductions in
10 cost-sharing shall be allowed under section 1402 of the
11 Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (42 U.S.C.
12 18071) before the date that the Secretary of Health and
13 Human Services certifies to the Congress that there is in
14 place a program that verifies, consistent with section 1411
15 of such Act (42 U.S.C. 18081), the household income and
16 coverage requirements of individuals applying for such
17 credits and cost-sharing reduction.

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
