AN ACT

To amend the Public Health Service Act to eliminate the non-application of certain State waiver provisions to Members of Congress and congressional staff.

1 **SECTION 1. ELIMINATION OF NON-APPLICATION OF CER-**
2 **TAIN STATE WAIVER PROVISIONS TO MEM-**
3 **BERS OF CONGRESS AND CONGRESSIONAL**
4 **STAFF.**

5 If the American Health Care Act is enacted, effective
6 as if included in the enactment of such Act, section
7 2701(b)(5)(A)(ii) of the Public Health Service Act (42
8 U.S.C. 300gg(b)(5)(A)(ii)), as added by subsection (a) of
9 section 136 of the American Health Care Act (relating to
10 permitting States to waive certain ACA requirements to
11 encourage fair health insurance premiums), is amended by
12 striking “1312(d)(3)(D),”.
